TE HUARAHĪ (Pathway)

Our Ratonga (service) delivery model incorporates Professor Mason Durie's model of Te Whare Tapa Wha (The Four Cornerstones) enhances holistic healing throughout the four cornerstones of health:

- Hinengaro (mental wellbeing)
- Tinana (physical wellbeing)
- Wairua (spiritual wellbeing)
- Whānau (family wellbeing)

Professor Charles Rapp's Strengths Model complements Te Whare Tapa Wha, interweaving the strengths of community, whānau and hapu.

RATONGA (Service)

- A whānau group that provides support for Māori.
- Opportunity to educate tangata whaiora, whānau and significant others, to better understand mental wellbeing through the recovery models of Strengths, W.R.A.P. and Te Whare Tapa Wha.
- Access to Kaumatua and Kuia to assist and provide support to all tangata whaiora, whānau and kaimahi.
- Access to a Māori Mental Health Support Worker.
- Access to Affinity's services.
- Peer Support Kaumatua home operating under Tikanga Māori.
- Support networks for dual diagnosis.
